Poster Session Guidelines

Poster format

- Poster size must be no more than 119 cm by 84 cm (A0 portrait size).
- The heading should have a font at least 35 mm high listing the title, author and coauthor names, the affiliation(s) and the contact details.
- It is recommended that the poster includes abstract, background and/or objectives, methods, results and conclusions in at least 10mm font.
- Any detailed format or material is acceptable. However, computer display equipment, sound or projection equipment, or freestanding displays are not permitted.

Set-Up/ Removal Procedures

- Poster Sessions will take place at the main venue of the ISAIA 2024 (Kyoto Institute of Technology, Matsugasaki Campus).
- All posters must be set up and taken down at pre-designated times. These times will be notified in due course, together with the final program.
- The poster presenters are required to prepare, carry, and mount their posters by themselves. Costs associated with creating and shipping the poster display will be the responsibility of the authors.
- The location of each poster will be assigned by poster number that you will receive in due time, together with the final program.
- The board, pushpins or scotch tape will be provided and should be used to mount the poster.

Presentation Procedure

- All posters will be displayed throughout the conference.
- Presenters are to remain by their poster during the designated session time. This
 session time will be notified in due course, together with the final program.
